2 HISTORICAL ARCHITECTURAL, ARCHEOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE OF PROJECT  The Reddick Mansion is a unique Italinatate residence built in 1855-58 by William Reddick, Architects Olmsted & Nicolson. The Italinatate design is a colorful contrast of light stone and rich red brick, with a gracefull stairway to the entrance, and beautifull polygonal bays supporting a two story porch. The Interior contains 7 original carved marble fireplaces and magnificent ornamental ceilings in the large parlors, halls, and other rooms. Adjacent and supplemental to the mansion and on the same lot, is the caretakers residence of the same period and architecture. The intended purpose of this work project is to stabilize, restore and preserve this cottage with roof repairs. The Reddick Mansion is used for public meetings, public oriented not-for-profit offices, and exhibition rooms. It is open daily.
