

THIS INDENTURE made this the tenth of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between William R. Campbell of the one part and William Redick of the other part Witnesseth: That William Redick of his own free will and accord has put and placed himself and by these reasons doth put and place himself as an Apprentice to said William R. Campbell of Brownsville, with him as an apprentice he shall continue and serve wherever said Campbell may think proper to work (provided it shall not be out of the United States) for the term of Two years two months and twenty one days, at which time said apprentice will be twenty one years of age --- during all which term the said apprentice his said Master shall serve well and faithfully, his secrets keep, his lawful commands cheerfully do and obey, hurt to his said Master he shall not do nor wilfully suffer to be done by others. The goods of his said Master he shall not embezzle or waste, nor lend them to any without his consent -- at Cards, dice or other unlawful Game he shall not play, Taverns or alehouses he shall not frequent, Matrimony he shall not contract, from the service of his said master he shall not depart, or at any time absent himself, without his masters consent, - but in all things as a good and faithful apprentice shall and will demean and behave himself toward his said Master, and all his, during said term. -- And the said Master on his part by these presents doth agree to teach and instruct, or cause to be well and fully taught and instructed. The said apprentice in the Trade mystery or occupation of Blowing and flattening Windowglass in the best way and manner he can within said term, and also find and allow unto said apprentice so sufficient, meat, drink, including, lodging and wearing apparel, and all other things fit and convenient for such an apprentice during said term; and also at the end of said term shall allow and give said apprentice a full suit of clothes to cost not less than dollars. -- In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and date first above written. --
