

The Reddick Mansion is a unique Italianate ~~at~~ residence built in 1855-58 by W<sup>m</sup> Reddick, Architects Olmsted & Nicolson. The Italianate design is ~~a~~ colorful contrast of light stone and rich red brick, a graceful stairway to the entrance, and ~~with~~ <sup>has</sup> beautiful polygonal bays supporting a two story porch. The interior contains original marble fireplaces, and magnificent ornamental plaster ceilings in large parlors and other rooms. Adjoining is the caretakers residence of the same period. This project is to restore, and preserve the cottage with roof repairs. The building is used for public meetings, ~~quasi~~ public oriented. not for profit ~~events~~ <sup>events</sup> and exhibition of period rooms.
